Changes or additions to agenda

Mayor Reazin moved to approve consent items, motion seconded by Commissioner Bruce, all ayes, motion carried, 4-0.

Public comments

Public comments were invited and none were heard.

Business Items

- A. Consider 2nd Quarter Planning & Codes Department report

Codes Administrator Curt Baumann and Codes Enforcer Gordon Snyder presented the 2nd Quarter Building & Codes report. The focus for the 3rd Quarter will be clearing the public walkways of trees and hedges.

B. Consider request to serve alcohol as part of the Great Kaw Adventure Race on September 30, 2017
Assistant to the City Manager Leslie Herring reported the GKAR committee chair, Justin Eddings is in attendance to review the exact course of the race and the request permission to sale, possess and consume alcohol on Saturday, September 30. Mr. Eddings reviewed the course with the Governing Body. The area requested to allow alcohol is 9th Street between Main and Maple Streets; extending D Dubs restaurant out into 9th Street. It will not extend in to CPA Park. The committee will be reaching out to other vendors and organizations to attend the event.

Mayor Reazin moved the City Commission approve the sale, possession and consumption of alcohol on Saturday, September 30, 2017 from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm on 9th Street between Main and Maple Streets for the Great Kaw Adventure Race, motion seconded by Commissioner Born, all ayes, motion carried, 4-0.

- C. Consider date for 2018 budget public hearing

City Manager Barack Matite commented the Governing Body needs to set a time and date for a public hearing for the proposed 2018 budget following the work session on July 20th.

Mayor Reazin moved the City Commission set a public hearing for the proposed 2018 budget on August 14, 2017 at 7:00 pm, motion seconded by Commissioner Bruce, all ayes, motion carried, 4-0.

Mayor and City Commission Comments

Mayor Reazin noted comments on Facebook indicated the longest electric outage was twenty minutes which he thought was very good. Clerk Schmeck supplied a list of allowable reasons for executive session and sample motions for the Governing Body to use following legislative changes.

City Manager and Staff Comments

City Manager Barack Matite commented Public Works Director Mike Hutto and city crews did a very good job restoring power to citizens that were affected by the storm on Saturday.

Public Works Director Mike Hutto reported there were 96 outages at 10:45 pm on Saturday and by Sunday, 5:00 am all the power was restored to those citizens. The gridstream was very helpful in trouble shooting problems with the lines.

Police Chief Bill Edwards – No comment.

Fire Chief Ken Keiter complimented Public Works on their efforts in restoring power. He complimented the Police and Fire Departments in working together to assist a citizen during the storm. He also complimented Recreation Director Gary Scott and the employees at the aquatic center for their response to a medical emergency in the pool.

Parks & Recreation Director Gary Scott commented staff did a good job responding to the medical emergency at the aquatic center. Response time from the first responders was great. They were at the scene in a couple of minutes. Sign up for youth activities are currently going on.

City Clerk Pam Schmeck – No comment.

Mayor Reazin moved to recess into executive session for one hour for consultation with the City of Eudora's attorney which is deemed privileged in the attorney/client relationship pursuant to the attorney/client relationship, K.S.A. 4319(b)(2) and return to the City Commission chambers at 8:25 pm, motion seconded by Commissioner Bruce, all ayes, motion carried, 4-0.
