Business Item

A. Consider proposal from Rural Water District #4

While discussing the Rural Water District #4 proposal, the Commission decided to respond to the proposal with the following;


- \$8,000 per existing meter charge (adjusted for inflation)
- N. 1200 Road with the 40 acres to the south, which is in the city limits already, be part of the city's proposed service area boundary
- City of Eudora residents, within the District's territory, should pay the same rates for water whether supplied by the city or the rural water district
- All infrastructure installed by RWD #4 to provide water service to city residents within the city limits will meet city code including fire protection standards
- The District will send the city a 60 day notice of intent to provide water service including fire protection to any new property annexed into the city
- The District will have 12 months to provide sufficient water service including fire protection to the annexed property
- The City would be willing to establish an emergency water connection

City Manager Matite will draft a memorandum, reflecting the above consensus, and provide it to the Mayor to present to the RWD at the next board meeting which was scheduled for Thursday, August 24th at 6:30 pm.


Mayor Reazin left the meeting at 6:15 pm.
